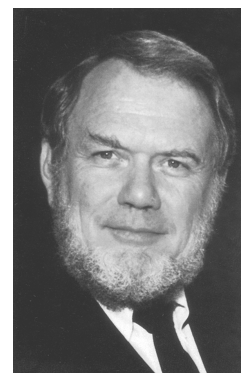
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Dr. William R. Jackson, PhD, ScD

(August 23 1936 – January 24, 2020)

Biographical and Book Information

Dr. William R. Jackson was born and raised in a farm community near Boise, Idaho. An author, educator, researcher, and entrepreneur with a wide range of professional and personal interests, Dr. Jackson earned a Ph.D. from the University of Denver, an Sc.D. from Northwest Nazarene University, and continued both formal and self-directed educational pursuits, including completion of postdoctoral study at the Stanford University Advanced Management College. Dr. Jackson traveled through Canada, Europe, China, and Mexico to research agriculture, animal health, human health, and environmental issues and their possible solutions, and was involved in hazardous and toxic substance reduction research at Southwest Research Institute in San Antonio, TX.



Dr. Jackson authored several curriculum textbooks as well as other publications and gave many professional presentations.

Dr. Jackson was awarded FIRST PLACE in the Non-Fiction Book category of the 1994 National Self-Publishing Awards by Writer's Digest for his book *Humic, Fulvic, and Microbial Balance: Organic Soil Conditioning*. First in a series, this text is a thorough reference book that summarizes more than nine years of concentrated research and writing interests. Written for a diverse audience, the text is beneficial for gardeners, farmers, ranchers, agricultural researchers, and all those who are interested in safe, sane, and productive growing. It is also a requisite text for those who care about nature's natural, biochemical remediation processes. Chapter topics include humification, humic and fulvic phenomena, water, nature's nitrogen cycle, organo-clays, growth regulator stimulants, and toxic waste remediation. The *Bulletin of the International Society of Soil Science* gives *Humic, Fulvic, and Microbial Balance: Organic Soil Conditioning* a positive, supportive review.

LIFE: MORE ABUNDANT, Volume II of the series, was published in 2016, and Volume III, *HYPERBARIC OXYGEN ... AND BEYONE*, was published in 2018.

In 1995, Dr. Jackson published *Environmental Care & Share, Working Model Constructs Which Suggest: “We can do better”*. It reviewed the roles played by individuals, institutions, and entities that affect the

environments of our world. It also described government regulations and regulatory bodies, corporations (including insurance companies and unions), and individuals who hold various positions of influence. For reference, he added the original California Proposition 65 as well as EPA and OSHA tables that list chemicals known at that time to be toxic, hazardous, carcinogenic, and apparent birth-defect precursors. Not wanting to just point out problems, he shared how the health and safety of earth's inhabitants can be improved through the use of safe, non-toxic & non-hazardous products.

During that year, he also wrote four (4) booklets: *Fabulous Fulvic Electrolyte*, *The Calcium Deception*, *The Arthritis, Osteoporosis, and Silica Link*, and *Silver for Human Health*.

1997 saw Dr. Jackson returning to issues of agriculture and animals with the completion of two articles: "Dynamic Growing for Master Gardeners" and "Microorganisms Plus Bio-Stimulant for Master Gardeners," which were presented during two lectures at the Master Gardener International Conference sponsored by the University of California at Davis. Two articles, "Humus and the Makeup of Soil" and "Microorganisms: How We Can Assist Them," were presented at ACRES USA seminars.

An article, "Some Functions of Enzymes," researched and co-authored by Dr. Jackson, was published in the August 1997 *Poultry Digest*. ACRES USA published an interview with Dr. Jackson by Charles Walters entitled, "Restoring Life to the Soil" in November 1997. This was followed by the article "Protecting Your Soil's Microorganisms" in December 1997.

In 2002, Dr. Jackson researched and co-presented "From Humic Substances in Academia to the Needs of International Commerce" to the Twentieth Conference of the International Humic Substance Society. In October 2002, Dr. Jackson's article, "Reduction of Hazardous Levels of Agricultural Nitrogen in Water and Soil," was published in the *Journal of Medical Hypothesis*.

To help provide alternatives to toxic and hazardous chemical products, Dr. Jackson collaborated with like-minded entrepreneurs that led in the formulation of numerous safe products for agriculture (including livestock), industry, and human use. All products within The Answer® line of products are Listed by the Organic Material Review Institute (OMRI) as approved for use by certified Organic® production and processing. He also teamed up with several established companies in the promotion of electrolyzed oxidizing (EO) water equipment to provide a way to clean, disinfect, and sanitize without hazardous or toxic chemicals.

During the last several years Dr. Jackson also wrote books of personal philosophy and faith:
